## **Revised Guide for Board Members of Charitable Organizations**

On December 22, 2022, the office of Massachusetts Attorney General Maura Healey released a revised Guide for Board Members of Charitable Organizations (the "Guide"). Last updated in 2015, the Guide contains valuable guidance for board members regarding their rights and responsibilities, and lays out the expectations of the Attorney General's Office regarding best practices, leadership composition and diversity, financial accountability, and conflicts of interest. The Guide is a helpful resource which all Massachusetts charitable organizations should consider providing to board members to assist them with their responsibilities.
